#### Pfizer Vaccine Benefits and Safety

- Randomized trial included over 40K people
- Vaccine was found to be effective in all ages including > 75 yrs
- Predictable symptoms at the site and systemically commonly occur and increase after the second dose
  - Most reactions and symptoms are mild to moderate
- Approved for individuals 16 and older





#### **Use Among Specific Populations**

- Contraindicated among people with
  - o history of anaphylaxis to injection vaccines or ingredients
- Approved for use among
  - o Pregnant women
    - pregnant or breastfeeding should discuss risks versus benefits with their clinician.
  - o immunocompromised individuals
    - such as those with HIV were included in the trial, there were not enough participants to draw any conclusions about the vaccine's effectiveness in this group.



#### Summary of Reactions and Adverse Events

Immediate reactiion	0.4%	0.4%	0.3%	0.2%
Site reaction <sup>1</sup>	78.6%	12.8%	73.1%	10.6%
Systemic Symptoms <sup>2</sup>	59.1%	47.0%	69.9%	33.8%



# Severity of Systemic Symptoms after Dose 2 for 18- to 55- year old





- 1. Start preparing now
- 2. Identify individual to serve as coordinator from facility
- 3. Use AHCA/NCAL's facility vaccine clinic checklist
- 4. Work closely with partner pharmacy
- 5. Ask questions






#### Collecting Consent

- CVS and Walgreens have now indicated they will accept the following for consent:
  - Documentation of verbal consent
  - o Emailed consent
  - o Electronic signature
  - Hard copy signature
- CVS and Walgreens instructions may not reflect this change
- Discuss details with pharmacy partner





- Be transparent
  - Straightforward and clear communication on safety, efficacy and side effects
  - Combat misinformation with facts
  - Stay informed
  - Provide information from trusted sources (CDC, FDA)





#### Manage expectations

- Infection control practices and testing are likely to continue postvaccine
- Two doses are needed
  - Full protection 14 days after dose two

#### Motivate

- o This will protect your family, co-workers and your residents
- Leaders in the community
- o Opportunity to get the vaccine now, before widely available
